

OUR CLOSEST BEACHES

TOROK BEACH

Directly adjacent to Samara Bay and connected to Samara Hills Pristine white sand and clear turquoise waters. Try Amber Resort for lunch and refreshing drinks. This beach is home to the future Samara Beach Club.

PENGANTAP BEACH

This beach is typically harder to reach unless you are a Samara owner taking advantage of the direct access from Samara Hills. The beach is still very much un-touched +offers breath-taking views of the Indian Ocean and stunning sunsets. It's also known for snorkelling and turtle spotting.

SELONG BELANAK BEACH

Only 5 minutes away from Samara and frequently voted as the best beach in South-East Asia. It is a favourite with families and beginner surfers with a gentle sandy beach break. There are a range of local beach stands offering pizzas, coconuts, beers and surf boards. Alternatively, it is also home to Laut Biru restaurant (see below).

SERANGAN BEACH

A favourite for surfers due to the consistent waves coming out of low tide. It is also surrounded by a range of beach bars and restaurants where visitors can relax and enjoy delicious food while taking in the beautiful ocean views. These include Boni Beach Resort, Segara Lodge and Surfing Point 9 Resto.


MAWI BEACH

Is another surfers beach that is protected from on-shore wind and best at mid-tide. Beautiful beach to also just sit, watch the world go by and enjoy a coconut. Sun-beds available for rent and a few beach warungs providing refreshments. However, road to get there is unpaved and quite bumpy on a scooter.

SEMETI BEACH

Visitors can explore the beach's rocky coastline, natural rock pools, and tidal lagoons, which are home to a variety of marine life such as colourful fish and crabs. If you are looking for a secluded beach, this is your spot.







ACTIVITIES - SURFING

South Lombok boasts some fantastic surfing spots. Here are a few:

KUTA BEACH

Famous for its white sandy shores and consistent waves, Kuta Beach offers something for surfers of all levels. Beginners can enjoy smaller waves closer to shore, while more experienced surfers can head out to the reef breaks for bigger swells.

SEGER BEACH

Just a short drive from Kuta, Seger Beach is known for its stunning scenery and great waves. Intermediate to advanced surfers will appreciate the reef breaks that produce fast and hollow waves, especially during the dry season.

GERUPUK BAY

A popular surfing destination with multiple breaks catering to different skill levels. Inside Gerupuk Bay, you'll find mellow waves perfect for beginners, while outside the bay, experienced surfers can challenge themselves with larger swells.

SELONG BELANAK

Ideal for beginners and longboarders, Selong Belanak offers gentle, rolling waves and a picturesque setting. The sandy bottom makes it a safe and forgiving spot for those learning to surf.

MAWI

Provides mellower waves on high tide for less experienced surfers. Best on mid tide where fun barrels are at the most perfect.

SERANGAN BEACH

Reef break - best surfed on a mid-low tide. it is also very wind-sensitive, so best to surf Serangan on a low-wind day, or early in the morning.

ACTIVITIES - SNORKELLING

GILI NANGGU

This small island off the southwest coast of Lombok offers crystalclear waters and vibrant coral reefs teeming with marine life. Snorkelers can expect to see colourful fish, sea turtles, and even reef sharks in these pristine waters.

GILI LAYAR

Just a short boat ride from Gili Nanggu, Gili Layar is another fantastic snorkelling spot known for its diverse marine ecosystem. The coral gardens here are home to an array of tropical fish, making it a paradise for underwater enthusiasts.

 Gili Sudak: Located near Gili Nanggu, Gili Sudak is renowned for its shallow coral gardens that are perfect for snorkelling. The calm waters and abundant marine life make it an ideal spot for beginners and families.

SECRET GILIS

These lesser-known islands off the coast of South Lombok offer secluded snorkelling spots away from the crowds. With pristine reefs and clear waters, the Secret Gilis are perfect for snorkelers looking for a peaceful underwater experience.

ACTIVITIES - FISHING & SPEARFISHING

Take a local boat and spend the day fishing with a local guide.

FISHING SPOTS

GILI ISLANDS

The waters surrounding the Gili Islands are known for their rich marine life, making them excellent fishing grounds. Chartering a boat from one of the local operators on Gili Trawangan, Gili Air, or Gili Meno can take you to prime fishing spots where you can catch a variety of species including tuna, barracuda, and snapper.

SEKOTONG PENINSULA

The Sekotong Peninsula on the southwest coast of Lombok offers numerous fishing opportunities. From Sekotong, you can hire a local boat and guide to take you to nearby reefs and fishing grounds where you can target reef fish and pelagic species.

SOUTHERN COASTLINE

The southern coastline of Lombok, particularly around Kuta and Selong Belanak, provides excellent shore fishing opportunities. Look for rocky points, estuaries, and reef areas where you can cast your line for a chance to catch snapper, grouper, and lobster.

SPEARFISHING SPOTS

GILI ISLANDS

The clear waters surrounding the Gili Islands are ideal for spearfishing. Head to the outer reefs and drop-offs for the best chances of encountering a variety of reef fish species.

SOUTHWEST COAST REEF

The reefs along the southwest coast of Lombok, near Sekotong and Ekas Bay, are popular spearfishing spots. These areas are home to an abundance of reef fish and offer excellent visibility for spearfishing.

SECRET GILIS

The Secret Gilis, a group of small islands off the coast of South Lombok, offer secluded and pristine spearfishing spots. Explore the underwater terrain around these islands for a chance to encounter a diverse range of marine life.

ACTIVITIES - HIKING

South Lombok offers some fantastic hiking opportunities amidst its stunning landscapes.

MOUNT RINJANI TREK

The most iconic hiking destination in Lombok, Mount Rinjani offers a challenging yet rewarding trekking experience. Standing at 3,726 meters (12,224 feet), Rinjani is Indonesia's second-highest volcano. The trek typically takes 2–4 days, with highlights including crater rim viewpoints, Segara Anak Lake, hot springs, and the summit itself.

BENANG STOKEL WATERFALL HIKE

For a more leisurely hike with beautiful scenery, consider visiting Benang Stokel Waterfall. Located in central South Lombok, this hike takes you through lush forests and across suspension bridges to reach the stunning twin waterfalls. It's a perfect day trip for nature lovers and those seeking a refreshing dip in the natural pools.

TANJUNG RINGGIT COASTAL HIKE

Explore the rugged coastline of South Lombok with a hike along the Tanjung Ringgit peninsula. The trail offers panoramic views of the ocean and cliffs, as well as opportunities to discover hidden beaches and caves along the way. Don't forget your camera to capture the breathtaking scenery!

SELONG HILL HIKE

Enjoy sweeping views of Selong Belanak Bay and the surrounding countryside with a hike up Selong Hill. The trail starts from the village of Selong Belanak and winds its way up the hill, passing through lush vegetation and offering stunning vistas at the summit. It's a relatively easy hike suitable for all skill levels.

SEMBALUN VILLAGE HIKE

Immerse yourself in the local culture and natural beauty of South Lombok with a hike around Sembalun Village. Explore rice terraces, traditional Sasak villages, and scenic countryside as you learn about the island's rich heritage and way of life.




